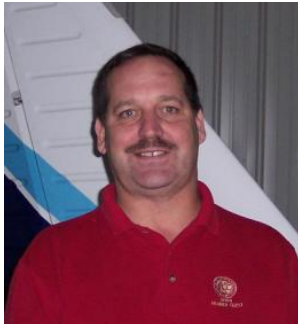
A projected slide show was shown of our last two club events, to the delightment of all.
