**FROM THE PRESIDENT**

At the April meeting, the membership overwhelmingly voted in the Hull Protection Program and stipulated that it begin June 1st of this year. This means that the May meeting will amend the Bylaws to include the new program structure, and that owner members will need to either participate in the Hull Protection Program, or provide evidence of commercial insurance that provides hull replacement coverage. If one or the other is not satisfied by June 1st, temporary loss of flight privileges results.

The Board of Directors has reviewed hourly rates determined that an adjustment is not required at this time. Rates are scheduled to be reviewed again in October. Beginning July 1st, monthly dues will increase to \$20/mo. This will be the first increase in dues in over 30 years. It will help fund fixed-cost expenses for things we enjoy now that we didn't have 30 years ago.... like nonmoving insurance coverage on the aircraft, an increase in liability insurance coverage, electricity, natural gas, telephone, internet access, and so on.

**UPCOMING EVENTS**

The last Saturday in May is Wash & Wax day. The day will include a spot landing contest, a cookout, and possibly a flour bombing contest.

Saturday, June 12th, is our Pancake & Sausage event this year. Volunteer signup for our only fund raiser of the year will be on the hangar office door.

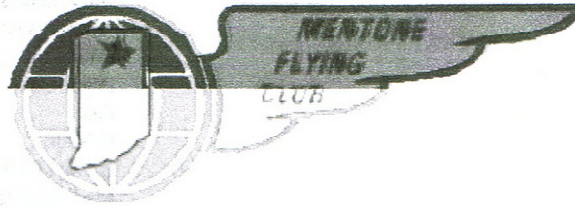
4378Q – Just completed the annual. Good to go.
