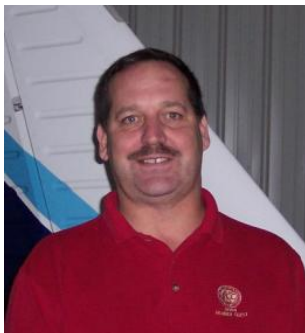
Upcoming club events are:
